This 'Extra Brut' Vintage Champagne is 30% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Noir and 50% Pinot Meunier. Good balanced acidity and that distinctive baked apple palate. 12% ABV.

Equal parts Cabernet and Merlot. New to my list reports are of chocolate and cloves on the nose, and plenty of evidence of oak on the palate. I have yet to decide. 13% ABV.

Domaine Andre Brunel, Rhone
Attractive and versatile medium-bodied food wine made of the typical Rhone blend of Grenache, Cincault and Syrah but sourced from two plots located to the East and the West of the Cotes du Rhone. 14.5% ABV.

Terrasses du Larzac, Coteaux du Languedoc
Rich rounded blend of Syrah and Grenache. Cherry and blackcurrent, spices, tobacco and mocha with a little liquorice on the finish. Powerful but balance. 15% ABV.

VINSOBRES - Les Cornuds Magnum 2015 £85.00
Famile Perrin, Orange, S France
This is a pleasing, dry, red from the Southern Rhone's newest Cru. Made by the Family Perrin of Beaucastel fame. The magnum (2 x 75cl bottle size) is a good format for aging, so starting to drink at its full potential. 14.5% ABV.
